



Declared Stewardship Policy

Christian Stewardship Services shall guide and assist individuals in the stewardship of property which the Lord has entrusted to them. To carry out this role, CSS will provide or make available adequate training for its Representatives and staff. CSS shall have policies which provide or state that:

1. No portion of the remuneration of Representatives and other staff shall be based on gifts received by CSS or gifts committed to it.
2. Donors are advised and encouraged to seek independent professional advice before making a gift to CSS or its partners which, in the opinion of the Representative or other member of staff, might significantly affect the donor's financial position or might adversely affect the donor's relationship with family members.
3. Donors are provided with comprehensive and current information regarding CSS and its ministries.
4. Gifts (if any) which are designated for the support of a particular ministry of CSS, or which are to be used for a particular project or purpose approved by CSS, are used solely for such purpose or purposes.
5. Gifts will not be accepted for projects which are not within the bounds of CSS objects or have not been approved by the governing Board.
